All LMHA teams are considered for this award. It is presented to the team that best reflects excellence in a variety of areas, including but not limited to:

- Team spirit, sportsmanship, and overall enjoyment of the game
- Tournament achievements and performance throughout the season
- Player selflessness and resilience
- Adherence to the LMHA Code of Conduct

Junior and Senior Goalie of the Year

This award is presented to one junior and one senior goaltender who demonstrated a high level of performance, consistency, and contribution to their team. Selection is based on overall evaluation and not statistics alone.
